Frasier's Seniors for Seniors to Gift \$100,000 to Boulder County Agencies Serving Seniors

BOULDER, Colo.—<u>Frasier</u>, a Boulder-based retirement community, will award six local agencies serving seniors with a total of \$100,00 in grants to fund agency projects. Since the inception of the Frasier Community Fund Endowment, a total of \$295,000 in funds have been issued to local organizations.

WHAT: Check presentation and celebration

WHO: The six grantee agencies in attendance to accept their check include:

- Boulder County Area Agency on Aging (\$17,500)
- Boulder Housing Partners Foundation (\$42,500)
- Boulder Older Adult Services (\$7,500)
- Harvest of Hope: \$7,500
- Nederland Area Seniors: \$5,000
- Sister Carmen Community Center: \$20,000

WHERE: Frasier, The Canyons Center, 350 Ponca Place, Boulder, CO 80303

WHY: The Frasier Community Resource Fund Endowment was established in 2021. Funds from the endowment were earmarked for the Frasier Community Resource Program, created to engage residents to focus on supporting Boulder County nonprofits providing essential services to older adults as part of Frasier's social responsibility efforts.

HOW: The Seniors for Seniors, a Frasier resident advisory committee continually researches the unmet needs of seniors in Boulder County to learn what non-profit organizations are doing to help overcome funding challenges. Organizations are invited to submit grant applications for review and consideration. Grant award winners are approved by the Frasier Board of Directors.
